Please contact the pastor or the office to set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

Sacrament of Penance is administered every Saturday at 3:00 pm or by appointment at St. Sebastian Church.

Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children (RCIA):

Adults interested in becoming Catholic participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA). The Rite of Christian Initiation is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith. This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are interested, please call the office.

Sacrament of Marriage

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.



Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,

St. John the Baptist, the great prophet who announced the coming of the Lord, traveled and proclaimed the joyful message of repentance and many people welcomed his call to conversion, but some people mistook him for the messiah. On this occasion, St. John the Baptist humbly declared to them, "I baptize you with water, but there is one who will come after me who is more powerful than I, and I am not worthy to loosen his sandals." In today's Gospel we witness the power of Jesus in His words and deeds that amazed the people at his teaching and in His authority over the evil.

The people were oppressed by the scribes and Pharisees, who claimed to be religious but were actually hypocrites. They imposed heavy burdens on the people and did not care about their spiritual wellbeing. They preached about God but did not love Him with their hearts. Jesus saw through their deception and said, "these people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me." The scribes and Pharisees failed to bring the people closer to God, because they did not have a genuine relationship with Him themselves.

As Jesus starts to spread His message, a big shift is taking place. The Gospel tells us that, "the people were amazed at his teaching, because he taught them as one who had authority and not as the teachers of the law." Indeed, the teaching of Jesus was powerful, because he spoke the faith or proclaimed the word of God with great confidence and passion and taught values that he embodied.

One of the biggest problems in our world today is that we have leaders who are known for their violent control, coercion, vengeance, and lack of compassion for the people. Leaders are often dictatorial and disregard the rights and emotions of others, creating a chaotic world. If we want to change this current situation of the world, we need leaders who have inner authority. Every Christian is called to be such a leader, who can respect the rights and emotions of others with genuine love for God and others. Yes, the Christian call is to be a leader like Jesus, who can proclaim with confidence and zeal and practice what one proclaims.

Dear friends, to have inner authority, it is important that we allow the spirit of the Lord to come into our hearts. And Jesus says to us "Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me." Yes, the Lord is waiting to come into our hearts and make us a good leader like Him. Are you ready to be leader like Jesus? If you are ready, call yourself a Christian, if you are not ready, please don't call yourself a Christian.

Remember, a Christian is the person who manifests Christ through His life. So, are you ready to carry Jesus in your lives? *May God Bless you.*
