Please contact the pastor or the office to set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.</p> <p><b>Is anyone sick/admitted in the hospital?</b> If anyone is sick or admitted in the hospital, please let Pastor know or call the office.</p> <p><b>Sacrament of Penance</b> Sacrament of Penance is administered every Saturday at 4:30pm or by appointment at St. Sebastian Church.</p>	<p><b>Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children (RCIA):</b> Adults interested in becoming Catholic participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA). The Rite of Christian Initiation is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith. This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are interested, please call the office.</p> <p><b>Sacrament of Marriage</b> A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.</p>

**Dear friends in Jesus Christ,**

If I ask the question-what is the difference between Jesus and human beings; many will say that Jesus has two natures; divine and human, whereas we have only human nature. But I would say, just like Jesus we also have two natures, and the difference is that Jesus was able to highlight the divine nature in Him to all of us, whereas we highlight the human nature, just like our first parents. This is the reason, the Gospel of today is calling us for a big change in our lives- *“Repent, for the Kingdom of God is at hand.”* In other words, it is a call to turn from human nature to divine nature.

Jesus Proclaims; *“Repent, for the Kingdom of God is at hand.* The core message of whole Gospel is directed towards the establishment of the Kingdom of God, and in today’s world it is our responsibility to establish it, because it is for the same purpose, we are all created in His own image and likeness. We have been hearing this emergency call of Jesus to repent since many years. But how many of us have responded to this call positively? After repeated warning, why is it that we sit like the deaf? Why is it that we sit like not understanding? Is it about you and me Jesus is talking through the Gospel of Matthew 15:8, *“These people honor Me with their lips, but their hearts are far from Me.”* Is it not the prophet Jeremiah also says; *“Hear, O foolish people, and without understanding who have eyes, and see not: and ears, and hear not.”* (5:21)

We read from the Gospel that, it is with the arrest of St. John the Baptist, Jesus begins His preaching. It is from the culmination point of Jesus’ ministry the Apostles have taken up the mission of evangelization, and today it is the responsibility of every baptized person to continue the mission of Jesus and so the evangelization is an ongoing process and to happen this process without any beak only, every now and then Jesus comes to us through Gospel and to says-*“Repent, for the Kingdom of God is at hand.”* Remember, there is no place for human beings in heaven, but only for divine beings. As human beings we can become divine beings only through our repentance. So, we need to make a change from human to divine and share the divine qualities with every creature in this world. This is what, Pope Francis says always- *“A true Christian should be joyful,”* and we are called to share that joy of Christ with everyone.

Dear friends, ‘repentance’ also calls each of us to evaluate our faith and love in Jesus, because repentance is the fruit of our sincere faith and love for Jesus. It is an invitation to tune our life according to the rhythm of heavenly music rather than country music. The heavenly music is on, and Jesus is

looking down to each of us watching our dance step and He is not so happy, so He makes the correction again, *Repent, for the Kingdom of God is at hand.*

May the Eucharistic Lord, bless us with wisdom and knowledge that we may listen to His warning for ‘Repentance’ and know and believe that we are not only human beings, but also divine beings. **God Bless.**
