#### **Sacrament of Baptism**

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor or the office to set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

#### Is anyone sick/admitted in the hospital?

If anyone is sick or admitted in the hospital, please let Pastor know or call the office.

#### **Sacrament of Penance**

Sacrament of Penance is administered every Saturday at 3:00 pm or by appointment at St. Sebastian Church.

Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children (RCIA): Adults interested in becoming Catholic participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA). The Rite of Christian Initiation is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith. This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are interested, please call the office.

#### Sacrament of Marriage

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.

#### Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,

God is always speaking to us in different ways. He sent His messenger Gabriel to announce to Mary, and His servant Nathan to counsel David. He often makes Himself known to us through our loved ones, our companions, and our neighbors. He often manifests Himself to us through the afflicted, the needy and the lowly, and in everyone we meet. But do we realize the truth that God is communicating with us through others and circumstances?

As we get ready for Christmas, the wonderful celebration of God's love for us, we are encouraged to look at Mary as our example of faith and obedience. Today, we listen to the story of how the angel Gabriel told Mary that she would be the mother of Jesus; *"Hail full of grace! The Lord is with you."* The Gospel shows us that Mary was puzzled and wondered what kind of greeting this was. My dear friends, the first step to welcome Jesus into our hearts is to reflect on the word of God that we have heard in the last four weeks. It is not enough that we think about it, but it is vital that we cherish those words in our hearts. Receiving the word of God in our hearts is the same as carrying Jesus in our hearts, because the Word of God is God Himself.

When the angel came to Mary and told her what God had in mind for her, she was in a tough spot. She was already engaged, and she didn't know how her fiancé Joseph would react. But the angel reassured her and said, *"Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God."* That's what our guardian angel says to us too, but we're too distracted, so we don't listen. God wants us to have faith in Him and do what He says, even when it's hard or scary. Sometimes we worry too much about what other people will say or think, instead of what God will say or think. But God tells us today, don't be scared, because you have found favor with him.

God has a plan for everything. Mary was confused when she found out she was going to have a baby without being married. Sometimes we also feel puzzled by the things that happen in our lives. But we should have faith in God because nothing is impossible for Him. Mary said, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." Can we also be like Mary and follow God's will with all our hearts?

Dear Friends, I know life can be tough and scary sometimes, and you might feel like you have no clue what to do next, or how to handle things. But don't worry, there's always a way out, and there's always someone who loves you and cares for you. Just think of what Mary said when she found out she was going to be the mother of Jesus: "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." That's the attitude we need to have, too. If we can say yes to God's plan for us, we can also let Jesus into our hearts and experience his peace and joy. **God bless.**
