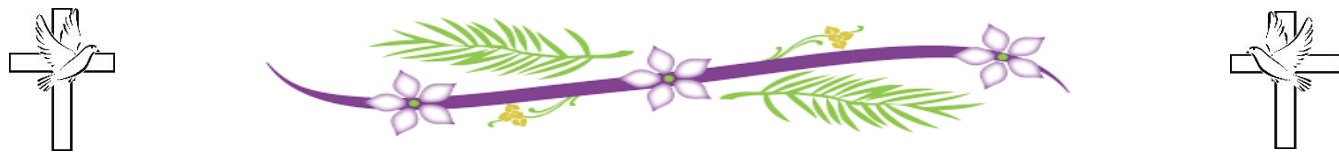

<p><b>Sacrament of Baptism</b> The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor or the office to set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.</p> <p><b>Is anyone sick/admitted in the hospital?</b> If anyone is sick or admitted in the hospital, please let Pastor know or call the office.</p> <p><b>Sacrament of Penance</b> Sacrament of Penance is administered every Saturday at 4:30pm or by appointment at St. Sebastian Church.</p>	<p><b>Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children (RCIA):</b> Adults interested in becoming Catholic participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA). The Rite of Christian Initiation is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith. This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are interested, please call the office.</p> <p><b>Sacrament of Marriage</b> A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.</p>



**Eucharistic Renewal beginning on Corpus Christi, June 19!**

All of the parishes and schools throughout our diocese- together with all of the dioceses in the U.S.-will be participating in an **extraordinary initiative to foster the renewed devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist and greater appreciation for the awesome gift of the Mass.** This renewal will continue over the next few years and eventually, will culminate in a National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis from July 17-21, 2024.

The Eucharistic Renewal focuses on four goals:

1. Foster belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.
2. Foster attendance at Mass, as well as valuing Mass in its entirety.
3. Encourage living in such a way so as to reflect the Eucharist in our daily lives.
4. Encourage sharing the truth, beauty, and goodness of Mass with others so that they in turn may be drawn to it.
