Please contact the pastor or the office to set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.</p> <p><b>Is anyone sick/admitted in the hospital?</b> If anyone is sick or admitted in the hospital, please let Pastor know or call the office.</p> <p><b>Sacrament of Penance</b> Sacrament of Penance is administered every Saturday at 4:30pm or by appointment at St. Sebastian Church.</p>	<p><b>Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children (RCIA):</b> Adults interested in becoming Catholic participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA). The Rite of Christian Initiation is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith. This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are interested, please call the office.</p> <p><b>Sacrament of Marriage</b> A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.</p>

**Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,**

When we celebrated the solemnity of Pentecost this past weekend, in the Gospel we saw that Jesus gave the Holy Spirit to His disciples by breathing on them and continued saying, "whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." By this clause, Jesus underlines the importance of love in each of us to experience the presence of the Holy Spirit. Today, as we are celebrating another great solemnity called the Holy Trinity, we are reminded that this is the celebration of love, a unity between Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit. Yes, the unity between the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit is the perfect symbol of love. This is the reason we call upon the presence of the Holy Trinity when we begin to celebrate the greatest love of Jesus, the Holy Eucharist and seal this love in us with the power of the Holy Trinity at the end of the Eucharistic celebration. So, as Christians, it is "in Him we live, and move and have our being." (Acts. 17:28)

Though, the Holy Trinity is three persons in one God, these three persons have their own duties to be performed though all of us. Though they have different natures, they are working towards only one goal, the establishment of the Kingdom of God. It is their focus on the goal that unites them together, that they cannot be separated. As Christians, if we really care for a peaceful life in this world and eternal life after our earthly life, we should allow the Holy Trinity to lead our life daily. Just as the Father in His wisdom created the world, we need the wisdom of God daily to do right things in our lives to create a blessed day for everyone. Just as the Son cared for us through His sacrificial love, we need a love like Jesus in our hearts to love and care for everyone to establish peace in this world. Finally, we need the strength of the Holy Spirit to carry our daily cross that will arise in the process of carrying out His mission in this world. To carry out His mission in this world is to sanctify this world with His grace of love, peace, joy etc. There is a beautiful prayer to the Most Holy Trinity, which beautifully expresses the different qualities of the three persons of the Holy Trinity, 'O Father who sought me, O Son who bought me, O Holy Spirit who taught me.'

Today, as we celebrate this great solemnity, the question that we should be reflecting is, what is the focus of my life as a Christian? Do I have the same focus as the three people in Holy Trinity? We all know that, if we do not have a focus in our lives, it is hard to succeed in our lives. If a husband and wife do not have focus in their lives and work towards that, their family life can be a miserable one. As members of the family of St. Sebastian or St. Charles, though we are all different if we all do not have a focus as that of the three persons in the Holy Trinity, the

mission of Jesus remains only as a proclamation, and no results will be seen.

Yes, to establish the Kingdom of God here on earth, a great sacrifice is demanded. Just as Father sacrificed His Son Jesus to us, just as Mary and Joseph sacrificed their personal will to God's will, just as Jesus sacrificed His life for our sins, just as all the saints in our Church sacrificed worldly pleasures for eternal life, each of us should be ready to sacrifice our own desires for the desire of our Father. This is the same sacrifice Jesus reminds us through the Gospel of Matthew 16:24, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me." So, as we continue to celebrate this Holy Mass, let us move around in this world in the presence of the Holy Trinity. May God the Father Bless us through His Son's love and by the strength and sanctity of the Holy Spirit.
