A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.

### Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,

Life is full of ups and downs. In the last weekend, the three disciples of Jesus were in their ups after witnessing the transfiguration of Jesus, but today we see they are down with their lack of faith or failure to discern Jesus who came to them walking on the water. During Jesus' ministry through His preaching, teaching, miracles, and healings Jesus tried to convince His disciples that He is the Son of God, but the disciples often failed. Though the disciples failed in Jesus many times, Jesus never failed his disciples. Though we all have failed in Jesus many times, Jesus never failed us and so we are here today. So, let us continue to live our lives with a grateful heart.

Like many other people, most of us may think; why did Jesus appoint one of the weakest disciples Peter as the head of the Church? If we closely examine the life of Peter, we can find that he had many failures and risings during his journey with Jesus. However, the lesson we need to learn from Peter is that he never hesitated to seek the help of his Master in his failures. Yes, his constant failures and constant dependance during failures helped him to love the Lord and trust the Lord more and more.

Though most of the disciples were very good fishermen, for a moment they were all scared to death. Though Jesus was not with the disciples physically, He was with them spiritually in prayer and He perceived the danger and reaches them for rescue. Yes, the Lord keeps watching over us all the time. He is ready to rescue us from the mess we are in; He is near to us when we are suffering with the powerful words "DO NOT BE AFRAID." Yes, let not fear control our mind, but let Jesus control our mind. Today, if you are in trouble, it is time to tell the trouble. Here, the failure of Peter is the failure of each one of us. The aim of Peter is to reach Jesus by walking on the water, but he failed to complete his task because instead of focusing his attention on Jesus, for a moment he was distracted and focused his attention on the blowing wind and lashing waves. Thus, Peter

lost control and began to sink, but Peter in his little faith cries out; "Lord, save me."

Today, as Christians the important task of each one of us is to reach God by focusing our attention on the footsteps of Jesus, so to say, follow the location Jesus has placed in each of us in the sacrament of Baptism. Yes, hit the location and follow the GPS. However, the distractions of blowing winds and lashing waves of worldly pleasures lead most of us to a life of problems and difficulties. But still the caring God is just closer to us with a message in our mess- "It is I do not be afraid." Our loving God is just closer to us to hear our cry- "Lord save me." The Good Lord is just closer to us with His extended powerful Hand to raise us up, Trust in Him.

The Book of the Prophet <u>Isaiah 59:1</u> reminds that, "Behold, the Lord's hand is not so short that it cannot save; nor is His ear so dull that it cannot hear." Today, through the Word of God and the Holy Eucharist, our Lord is so close to us. So let us ask Him earnestly, "Lord increase our Faith in You so that we will call upon you always in our lives." **God Bless.**
