This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. Sacrament of Marriage

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.

Dear friends in Jesus Christ,

Today we are living in a world of science and technology, produced by our own intelligence given by God. Today, we are creating a society and people addicted to science and technology, where technology talks more than human beings do. Sad to see parents introduce technology to their babies to feed them. Very sad to see some parents introduce technologies to their children in the Church to keep them quiet. Please remember, Church is a place to introduce God to your children. Please value the place where we are. Please respect the presence of God in the sacrament. Please be serious about the liturgy we celebrate. Yes, let us teach our children about the holiness of the Church and Sacraments we celebrate. Surely, it is our ignorance about the value of the holiness of the Church and Sacraments that makes us act contrary to the holiness of the Church and Sacraments. Often, we think that whatever we do in Church or during the celebration of liturgy is just okay, but remember it is not okay. Let us not make any compromise on our spiritual life.
