The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor or the office to set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

Sacrament of Penance is administered every Saturday at 3:00 pm or by appointment at St. Sebastian Church.

Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children (RCIA):

Adults interested in becoming Catholic participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA). The Rite of Christian Initiation is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith. This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are interested, please call the office.

Sacrament of Marriage

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.

As we enter the second week of Advent, we are filled with joy and anticipation for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ into our midst. He is the most important person we can ever welcome into our hearts and homes. He is the reason for our celebration and our hope. How do we prepare for His arrival? Do we just wait and see what happens, or do we make some effort to get ready? Imagine if a very important person, such as president or a king, was going to visit us. Do we want to make sure everything is in order and clean? Do we want to have some gifts and decorations to show our respect and love? Do we listen to the instructions of the representatives who would come ahead of time to check on the arrangements and security? If we know how to welcome a human VIP, remember that Jesus is much more important than any human VIP. He deserves our best attention and devotion. He sends us His messengers, the prophets, and the angels, to tell us what He expects from us and how to prepare our hearts for His coming. He wants us to repent our sins, to pray more, to love more, to share more, to serve more. He wants us to be ready to receive Him with joy and gratitude. He wants us to be His faithful friends and followers.

As we await the arrival of our honored guest, Jesus Christ, today we have a special visitor from Jesus' office who is here to inspect the preparations. His name is St. John the Baptist. Unfortunately, St. John the Baptist is not satisfied with the preparations we have made, so he gives us some advice; the Gospel says, "John the Baptist appeared in the desert proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sin." The advice of St. John the Baptist makes us realize that he is happy with all our external preparations. Surely some of us have already set up Christmas trees, Christmas gifts, Christmas dinner recipes, Christmas gathering etc., but are we ready with our internal preparations?

Yes, external decorations are needed, but if the same preparations are not done internally does it make any sense? The only preparation St. John the Baptist is demanding from each one of us is REPENTANCE. This Repentance is the act of seeking forgiveness from three people-forgiveness from God, forgiveness from our brothers and sisters and forgiveness from oneself. Now why do we need forgiveness or repentance? Through the Gospel, St. John the Baptist gives us the answer for it- "One who is coming after me is mightier than I. I am not worthy to stoop and loosen the thongs of His sandals". This sentence reveals the glory of Jesus and the meekness of St. John the Baptist. As we get ready for Christmas, we have the same mission as St. John the Baptist - to be humble and announce Christ's

arrival. Remember, only humble hearts can show true repentance, and only repentant hearts can welcome Christ, and only those who encounter Christ will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit, as St. John the Baptist says, "I have baptized you with water: He (Jesus) will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

This week, we have a wonderful opportunity to Repent and Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight His paths. This means that we are invited to align our lives with God's will, to seek His forgiveness and grace, and to share His love with others. We are called to be His faithful witnesses in the world, to spread His message of hope and salvation. May the Eucharistic Lord bless us with the needed grace to repent of our own sins to welcome Jesus into our hearts. God Bless you.
