Please contact the pastor or the office to set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.</p> <p>Is anyone sick/admitted in the hospital? If anyone is sick or admitted in the hospital, please let Pastor know or call the office.</p> <p>Sacrament of Penance Sacrament of Penance is administered every Saturday at 4:30pm or by appointment at St. Sebastian Church.</p>	<p>Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children (RCIA): Adults interested in becoming Catholic participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA). The Rite of Christian Initiation is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith. This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are interested, please call the office.</p> <p>Sacrament of Marriage A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.</p>

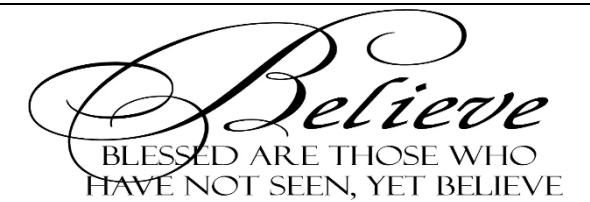

My dear Loving friends in Jesus Christ,

Believe it or not, we Catholics are the most blessed and luckiest people in this world, but very seldom do we realize this great truth. Although every human being in this world is looking for the gift of heaven after death, we Catholics have already received three beautiful gifts from heaven through Jesus Christ during our lifetime. If we Catholics can pay utmost care and respect to these gifts, be sure heaven is ours. The first gift from heaven by Jesus Christ is the Heavenly Father. Jesus gave us His father as our Father and gave the special privilege to call upon Him as our Father. The second gift from heaven by Jesus Christ is the beautiful prayer of Our Father. This prayer teaches us to love God and our neighbor, this prayer reminds us about our past, present, and future, and this prayer teach us the way to have a peaceful life. The third gift from heaven by Jesus Christ is the sharing of His own body and blood for all of us, the Holy Eucharist, through which Jesus comes to us and we get an opportunity to meet Him and experience Him.

Yes, today we celebrate the solemnity of this third gift of God from heaven, the most precious body and blood of Jesus Christ. During this celebration, let us ask the Eucharistic Lord to give us the grace to increase our faith in the Holy Eucharist and to become a Eucharist in our real life. Though, I ask you to pray for the grace to become a Eucharist in real life, it is not an easy task. Just look at the wine and bread that we use for our daily Mass! We just buy from a shop, and we don't much reflect about the process of making this bread and wine. To have this bread and wine in our hands, it takes the sacrifice of many people, and the process the wine and the wheat are going through to become a piece of bread and wine is a sacrifice like Jesus. The wheat and grape lost their apparent identity and so we have the bread and wine. Jesus was ready to give up His human nature to become the Holy Eucharist for you and me. The same way, we should be ready to give up our human nature and express our divine nature to become a Holy Eucharist in this world. This is exactly what St. John the Baptist says, "He must increase, and I must decrease." Yes, if we live for ourselves and our dear ones we die here, but if we live for everyone like Jesus without any discrimination we live forever like Jesus and Saints.

The celebration of the Most Precious Body and Blood of Jesus is an expression of Jesus' selfless love for all of us and the specialty of this love is, it is a covenantal love of Jesus with us. As we reflect, we can find a striking similarity between the old and new covenant. Moses spoke on Mount Sinai: "This is the blood of the covenant that Yahweh has made for you." (Ex 24:8). This Old covenant assured the

liberation of the people of Israel from the bondage of Egypt. When Jesus called the new covenant; "This is my blood, the blood of the covenant, poured out for many..." it assures the liberation of the whole humanity and this world from sin and death. We Christians are the members of the new covenant, but how much trust and faith do we have for this covenant of the Eucharist? With baptism we become the partakers of Jesus' Body and Blood, but how much value do we give to Eucharist in our lives? The problem with Christians is that, though he has the weapon against all kinds of evil in this world, he never realizes the power of it, The Holy Eucharist. There is no doubt dear friends, If you take your master Jesus seriously, He will take you seriously. It says that there is an uninterrupted celebration of the Holy Eucharist going on around the world and that is the reason the world still exists. I think, we need to believe and accept this saying, because our God is faithful to His promises, that in Mathew 28: 20 Jesus says, "...And behold I am with you always, until the end of the age." And Jesus is with us always through the Holy Eucharist. **May the Eucharistic Lord Bless us all.**
