<p>Sacrament of Baptism The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor or the office to set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.</p> <p>Is anyone sick/admitted in the hospital? If anyone is sick or admitted in the hospital, please let Pastor know or call the office.</p> <p>Sacrament of Penance Sacrament of Penance is administered every Saturday at 4:30pm or by appointment at St. Sebastian Church.</p>	<p>Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children (RCIA): Adults interested in becoming Catholic participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA). The Rite of Christian Initiation is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith. This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are interested, please call the office.</p> <p>Sacrament of Marriage A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.</p>

Focus on Faith
On the 2nd Thursday of each month, Sister Ann McGrew, an Ursuline Sister of Mount Saint Joseph, facilitates a "Focus on Faith" (FOF) book study, at St. Charles Parish Hall. Currently, we are reading the New York Times Bestseller and Christopher Award Winner "JESUS, A Pilgrimage" by James Martin, SJ. This particular book takes you through the Holy Land with Fr. James Martin and his friend Fr. George. We follow Jesus on this pilgrimage through Fr. James' eyes and it is an immensely rewarding read. While we are about halfway through the book, you don't have to start at the beginning to learn and enjoy, which is why we are again extending this invitation to anyone interested in attending this FOF study group. Typically, we prepare for each session by reading up to 3 chapters of the book. When we meet at the Parish Hall, we have a 1 ½ hour discussion session starting at 10:30 A.M. with lunch following at noon.
