Sacrament of Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor or the office to set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

Is anyone sick/admitted in the hospital?

Sacrament of Penance

Sacrament of Penance is administered every Saturday at 4:30pm or by appointment at St. Sebastian Church.

Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children (RCIA):

Adults interested in becoming Catholic participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA). The Rite of Christian Initiation is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith. This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are interested, please call the office.

Sacrament of Marriage

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.



Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,

After inviting us to get ready for treasure hunting this past weekend, the Gospel of today presents to us a glimpse of the greatest treasure called the Kingdom of God. The disciples who had the experience of the glimpse of the Kingdom of God never wanted to lose those moments for they say, "Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah." However, Jesus reminds them very clearly that they must make the sacrifice to have this treasure experience by saying, "Do not tell the vision to anyone until the Son of Man has been raised from the dead."

Let me ask you, how many of us really get excited when we talk about heaven? If we are sincerely excited about heaven, what is the preparation we make in our daily lives? If someone is not excited about heaven, no doubt he or she is not excited about his or her Catholic life either. Remember, Heaven is our final destiny. If we are not sure of our destiny, our life needs to be modified. Saint Theresa of Avila says, *"The more I meditate on heaven, the more I dislike this world."* No wonder, the disciples did not want to go down after the glorious experience they had.

The mountain is a place of prayer for Jesus and today we see Jesus is having the company of three disciples with Him-Peter, James, and John. Through His transfiguration, Jesus tries to teach them and teach us about what should be the outcome of our prayer. The Gospel says that "His face shone like the sun and His clothes became dazzling white as light." This is the reflection of Jesus' inner holiness. How many of us can pray like Jesus is the question we should be asking on this transfiguration Sunday. The entire mission of Jesus was around the Kingdom of God by doing the will of His Father in Heaven. As Catholics, what is our mission in our lives? Is it the same like Jesus or different from Him? As Catholics we might be making many prayers to the Lord every day and in our prayers, what is our focus? Do we focus on or pray for worldly things or Godly things?

Dear friends, experience of the glory of God is the promise of Jesus and should be the target of every one of us. The sacraments and the prayers in our Holy Catholic Church are the helping tools to achieve our target or find out the treasure that is hidden. So, our prayers should change/direct us towards our priority in our lives, our priority is none other than Jesus Christ. If this change is not happening through our prayer life, our prayer is not a prayer, but it is only a lip exercise. Yes, we should pray in such a way that miracles should happen in our lives and in the lives of other people. For the happening of the miracles through our prayer, the Gospel itself proposes the requirement, 'then from the cloud came a voice that said, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to Him.'" Remember the request of Mary our mother at the wedding feast at Cana: "Do whatever He tells you."

As we continue to celebrate this Holy Mass, let us ask the grace of the Lord to listen to Jesus and live accordingly, so that we will see His glory and radiate His glory through our lives in this world. **Amen**.
