Sacrament of Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor or the office to set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

Sacrament of Penance

Sacrament of Penance is administered every Saturday at 3:00 pm or by appointment at St. Sebastian Church.

Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children (RCIA):

Adults interested in becoming Catholic participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA). The Rite of Christian Initiation is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith. This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are interested, please call the office.

Sacrament of Marriage

A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.

Dear friends in Christ,

When I visit with the children and young people of our parish community, I often encourage them to make sure that they are praying for their parents and for their family. Being a parent has never been an easy responsibility, and these days it seems more complex than ever with the many demands that parents must manage. Family life, too, as we all know, comes with its own challenges, and so we are called to pray for one another, especially in family life.

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family, and we seek to follow the example of Saint Joseph, the Blessed Mother, and the Christ Child, as they sought to live the life of a holy family. They offer our families an example of what it means to live in holiness and faith.

The first thing we should note as we hear today's Scriptures is that the Holy Family knew its own share of heartache, challenge, and hardship. They were forced to travel far from home during the riskiest time of Mary's pregnancy, leading to their son's birth in a rough place and in conditions less than ideal. Shortly after the birth of Jesus, they are told that they must flee for their lives and for the life of their newborn son. They travel in haste to a distant land until they receive the message that it is safe for them to return. Their challenges resemble the challenges we experience in our own family lives.

The second thing we should note about the Holy Family is that in faith they listen for, and are open to, God's guidance in their lives. Both Mary and Joseph receive mysterious angelic visitors who share stunning and challenging news with them. Their trust in and openness to God are models for us to follow. Their family is guided by God, and they teach us to do the same.

One final thing we can note about the Holy Family is that they demonstrate the importance of the values held up for us in the second reading. Healthy doses of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience must have been theirs as they adapted to changing circumstances, new surroundings, and unseen challenges.

This Feast of the Holy Family holds up for us their example of simple trust and openness to God, and the faith which they shared. They show us that our families, even in times of challenge or uncertainty, can also be holy families – settings in which each of us can grow in kindness, humility, gentleness, and

peace. With faith and trust in God, we, too, experience family life in all its uncertainty and its wondrous beauty. **Amen.**
