<u>Sacrament of Baptism</u> The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor or the office to set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic. <u>Is anyone sick/admitted in the hospital?</u> If anyone is sick or admitted in the hospital, please let Pastor know or call the office. <u>Sacrament of Penance</u> Sacrament of Penance is administered every Saturday at 3:00 pm or by appointment at St. Sebastian Church.	<u>Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children (RCIA):</u> Adults interested in becoming Catholic participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA). The Rite of Christian Initiation is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith. This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are interested, please call the office. <u>Sacrament of Marriage</u> A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.

Our readings today remind us of an important truth, one which is found in the Book of Genesis, the very first book of the Bible: We are our “brother’s keeper” (Gen. 4:9). Behind this commandment to care about our brother or sister’s earthly and spiritual wellbeing is the God who desires his children to flourish in this life and to share his joy for all eternity.

The first reading and the Gospel make it clear that we should not sit idly by. God tells Ezekiel that he will be responsible for the wicked one's death if he does not try to *dissuade* him from his wicked way. And in the Gospel Jesus gives specific instruction about how to correct someone who has sinned against us in person. Notice his words: *Go and tell him his fault between you and him alone*. In other words, don't gossip or complain about the behavior to anyone else. Confront the person directly from a position of love.

Jesus acknowledges that, at times, we will encounter situations where fraternal correction seems fruitless. People are not always ready to change. That's where the Church can be a powerful intercessor. Jesus tells us that *if two of you agree on earth about anything for which they are to pray, it shall be granted to them by my heavenly Father*. In the end, only God can change hearts. But as the Church, we can join together in powerfully interceding for them, asking the Holy Spirit to move their hearts toward reconciliation.

As we come to this Eucharist, let us come with gratitude that our God longs for the salvation
