Sacrament of Baptism
The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is administered upon request. Parents and Godparents must attend class on Baptism in the Catholic Church. Please contact the pastor or the office to set up an appointment for this class at least a month in advance. At least one parent must be a practicing Catholic for their child to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, and at least one must be a practicing Catholic.

Sacrament of Penance is administered every Saturday at 3:00 pm or by appointment at St. Sebastian Church.

Rite of Christian initiation of adults and children (RCIA):
Adults interested in becoming Catholic participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA). The Rite of Christian Initiation is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith. This is for persons who are seeking baptism in the Catholic Church or full communion with the Catholic tradition through the Profession of Faith, reception of Eucharist and Confirmation. If you are interested, please call the office.

Sacrament of Marriage
A couple wishing to marry must contact the priest at least six months before the desired wedding date. According to the guidelines of our diocese, you should not make absolute plans for a specific wedding date until after meeting with the pastor. The couple will be required to attend a marriage preparation course which will include at least one formal program such as an Engaged Encounter weekend of the Sponsor Couple Program.

Dear friends in Jesus Christ,

The Gospel message of last weekend was that the experience of the Kingdom of God is a mystery, and this mystery happens in our lives in a mysterious way, just like that of a seed growing in the farm. Through the parable of the mustard seed, the Gospel also reminded us that, it is not enough that we experience the Kingdom of God, rather we should help others to experience the same and it is our responsibility. As we serve Christ and seek to extend His Kingdom, we are at war with the evil powers in this world. In today's Gospel we see that disciples are faced with a great obstacle during their missionary journey to the other side of the country. It is important to notice that leaving the crowd and the disciples' comfort zone, Jesus is asking His disciples to move to the other side. Remember, it is in our difficulties we prove our real quality.

Both the first reading from Job and the Gospel of Mark gives us the life message that God is the creator. Hence, He has the power to control and regulate all the natural, physical and spiritual forces or activities going on in this world. God knows the best time to intervene both in our personal lives and in the history of our entire world. This is very clear in His timely response to Job and His intervention in the situation of His disciples. Through the second reading, St. Paul reminds us that when God intervenes, He does so because of His love for us, and the gift of Jesus is a proven example for God's love for us.

As we reflect about the Gospel of today, we see there are four questions raised between Jesus and His disciples which are part of our lives and are raised even today by us. The four questions are;

- Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing? Asked by disciples and us
- Why are you terrified?
- Do you not yet have faith? Asked by Jesus to disciples and us
- Who then is this whom even wind and sea obey? Asked by disciples and us

Life is full of storms. At times, they can become so strong that our human strength can no longer support us and most of us raise the same type of question to God- God, do you not care that we are perishing? Why do you allow suffering in our lives? Why, has death taken the lives of our dear ones? Why this sickness etc., some people get answers from God, and they get back to normal, but some do not get their answer and continue to live their lives in tension and worries. The disciples asked the same question to Jesus-Jesus was asleep on a cushion and they woke Him and asked the question. Dear friends, this is the first step to be followed, before we raise the

the question to God-wake up the Spirit of the Lord that is sleeping in us and we will have the right answer for our different questions to God. To wake up the Good Spirit in us, we have sacraments, prayers and charitable works to be done.

Why are you terrified? Do you not have faith? is the response of Jesus to His disciples and to us. Fear is sponsored by the devil, and Faith is sponsored by God. Think, which sponsor has influenced you and influencing you? Through the Bible God says 365 times, "Do not be afraid". The number 365 times shows God's daily care and daily concern for each of us, still we are worried, scared of things and happenings. Jesus is asking each of us – Do you not have faith? Give an answer to Jesus.

Who then is this- whom even wind and sea obey? This question is raised from their excitement. Yes, up to now, we have come across so many small and big obstacles in our lives; did we ever try to find out the mysterious power behind all those moments? It is the same question Jesus had to face Himself on different occasions too. Yes, dear friends, our life should be a search for finding this mysterious power, to which everything in this world obeys. To find out we need to walk through His ways, read through His words and go through His entire life and be sure, that would give us enough Faith, to not to worry any more, because HE IS JESUS CHRIST. CHRIST YESTERDAY, TODAY AND FOREVER.
